

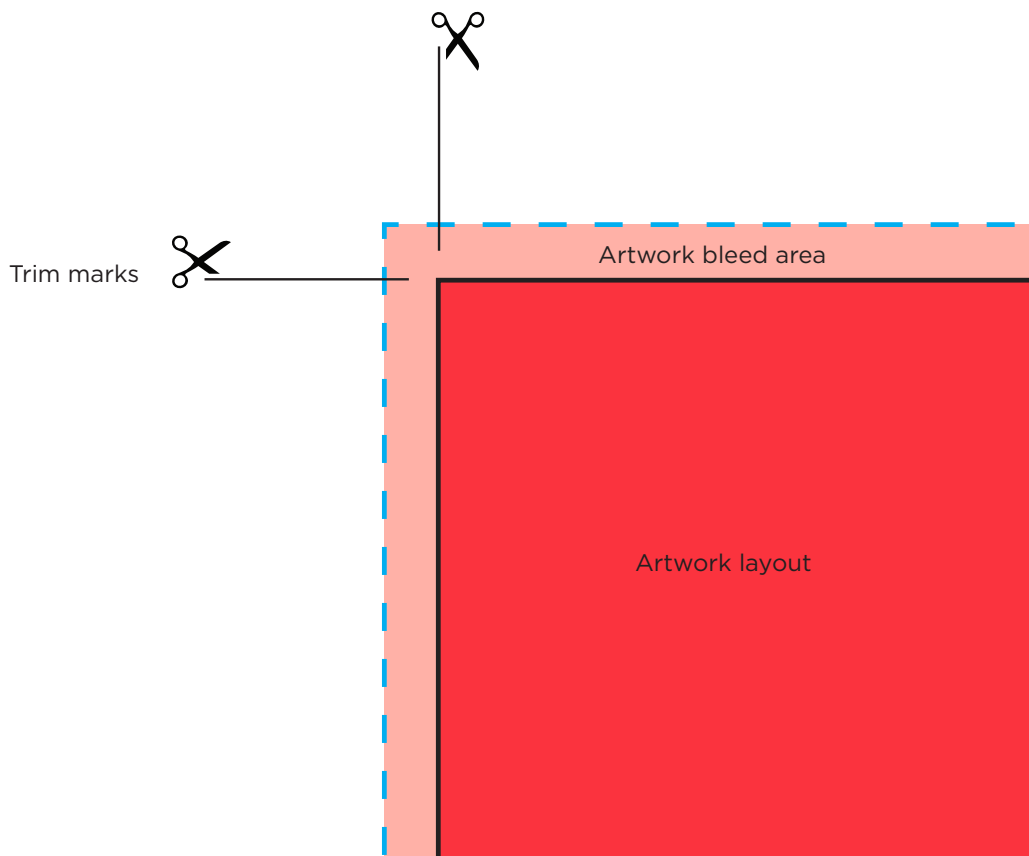
Bleed

What is it?

Bleed is a printing term that is used to describe a document which has images or elements that touch the edge of the page, extending beyond the trim edge and leaving no white margin.

Why is it important?

After trimming, the bleed ensures that no unprinted edges occur in the final trimmed document.



What is best for printing?

At least 0.125 (1/8) inch.

Ideal bleed 0.25 (1/4) inch.
